MBBS ADMISSION PROCEDURE IN NEPAL

Indian Candidate

Application

Indian applications of MBBS program, commencing in 2022, are open. Please apply online at <https://entrance.mec.gov.np/>. You would need to upload following documents while applying online: a) Recent passport size photograph b) Passport or Aadhar Card c) Transcript / marksheet of 10+2 or equivalent level (e.g., A Level) d) NEET/SAT score sheet e) Transaction reference no (last six digits) of the below application fee payment

Processing of Application

A confirmation page will be displayed after verification of bank payment, which can be saved/printed for future reference. It is not the Admit Card but a proof of online application form submission. Candidate to print their own Admit Card by providing details in the 'Check Application Status' page, which can be visited by clicking 'Check your status/print admit card' option in the home page. Admit Card can be printed before five days of the entrance examination date.

Entrance Exam

Medical Education Commission, Govt of Nepal will conduct a Medical Entrance Test (MET) and admissions would be based on the same (priority 1), as well as NEET which will be accepted for remaining seats (i.e., priority 2, however NEET qualified candidates must register at <https://entrance.mec.gov.np/>).

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered eligible for selection to the MBBS program, a candidate:

a) Must have qualified 10+2, A Level or equivalent examination, with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) securing a minimum of 50% in each PCB subject (which, in general, equals to minimum 'C' grades for Sri Lankan A Level and 'D' grades for International A Levels e.g., EDEXCEL/Cambridge) and 50% in aggregate.

b) Must have qualified Medical Entrance Test (MET) of the Medical Education Commission, Govt of Nepal or 50% percentile in NEET/equivalent exams.

Note

***To book seat in any of colleges, Student has to deposit INR 5,00,000 in college account.**

Other Expenses

1. Security Deposit (Refundable) = 1 Lakh
2. Hostel Fee + Mess Fee = 1 Lakh to 1.4 Lakh/Year
3. Miscellaneous Charges = 50 to 80 Thousand
